

SPORTS PREMIUM 2015/2016

Sport Premium is an amount of money which the government has agreed to allocate to schools to increase the quality & breadth of PE & Sport provision, and increase participation in PE & Sport. The funding amount received by schools is based upon the number of children of primary age at the school.

At Rothwell Primary, the PE team have the responsibility for developing PE and sport and deciding upon the effective use of Sport Premium Funding. We strive to promote healthy and active lifestyles and aim to provide sporting opportunities for all our pupils.
